From the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board Letter No. M1/13929/2018, dated 29.08.2018 and 08.12.2018.

Order:

The Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister has announced on 09.07.2018 in the State Legislative Assembly that the repairs and renewal works to roof slabs, floor slabs, balconies, staircases, laying of pressed tiles, water supply lines, sewage lines, water closets, etc., will be carried out for the tenements constructed by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. In order to upgrade 72000 tenements, Rs.70.00 crore will be spent in the next two years (2018-2019 and 2019-2020) out of State Budgetary Support. During the year 2018-2019, Rs.35.00 crore will be spent for these works and the rest of the amount i.e. Rs.35.00 crore will be spent for the year 2019-2020.

- 2. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has stated that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board was established in 1970 and has so far constructed 2.12 lakh tenements / houses on hire purchase / rental basis in the urban areas of Tamil Nadu till March 2018. The occupants of the tenements allotted on hire purchase basis, generally get the sale deed for their tenements after 20 years after which the allottees have to form societies and maintain the tenements. But this doesn't happen.
- 3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has also stated that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board cannot abdicate its responsibility for maintenance as it may lead to dilapidation of the

tenements and cause consequential accidents. Hence, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is maintaining both rental and hire purchase tenements in a block.

- 4. The specific repairs and renewal works, if any, are being carried out for the vulnerable tenements then and there due to resource constraints. The periodical maintenance and repair works like plastering, painting, colour washing, white washing, repairs to ceiling, roof slabs staircases to the slum tenements were not attended to the extent required.
- 5. In view of the above reasons, these tenements have become an eyesore, causing accidents in the tenemental schemes and consequential loss of lives and properties. Although, the life time of the concrete buildings are estimated at 70 years, these tenements become dilapidated in less than 30 years and warrant immediate reconstruction at prohibitive cost due to the absence of periodical maintenance and repairs works.
- 6. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has further stated that the scheme-wise detailed proposals for the repair and renewal works to be carried out is detailed in Annexure.
- 7. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has, therefore, requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction in principle to carry out repair and renewal works to 72,000 tenements at a cost of Rs.35.00 crore. The proposal for the balance amount of Rs.35.00 crore to be executed during 2019-2020 will be submitted separately after approval from the Board.
- 8. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for administrative sanction to carry out repair and renewals works to 72, 000 tenements as detailed in Annexure at an approximate cost of Rs.70.00 crore under state budgetary support during 2018-2020 subject to the condition that supervision charges in the estimation may be restricted to 5% instead of 12.5%.
- 9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.66315/ Hg&UD/2018, dated 05.02.2019.
